Beautification Ordinance

With the recent adoption of the Beautification Ordinance 09-04, the Mayor and City Council have received much positive participation from our residents. At this time, we would like to bring to your attention Section 11, Disposal of Trash which states that, "No trash, garbage or other waste or sanitary containers shall be visible **from the front of the house** except same may be placed outside the evening before any regular trash or garbage collection day, and until same is collected on said day." Citations will be issued to offenders effective July 1, 2010.

Change in Sanitation Service

Effective July 1, 2010, the city's sanitation service will be provided Anytime Waste Systems, and the day of collection has been changed from Wednesday to Tuesday. The last day of service by Waste Management will be June 30th, and on this day, they will be collecting sanitation along with their large totes. It is requested that your totes are placed at curbside on this day. Anytime Waste will begin to deliver their totes the week of June 28th. Due to the July 4th holiday, the first day of collection will be July 7th. The days of collection will be made on Tuesdays between 6:30a.m. and 5:p.m. Anytime Waste may observe the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. The weeks in which these holidays are observed, Anytime Waste will make collections on the next working day after the holiday.

It is unlawful for any person under age 18 to be or remain in or upon any public assembly, building, place, street, or highway within Jefferson County at night during the periods of 11p.m. to 6:00a.m. - Monday through Friday, and 1:00a.m. to 6:00a.m. - Saturday and Sunday. The parent(s) is/are cited for their child's curfew violations, and the fine \$157.00.
